## The Animal Sanctuary

There has been an Animal Sanctuary in Wilmslow for very many years. It was created by the Humane Education Society shortly after the Society was formed in 1927. The founding members were passionate about developing a deeper understanding and compassion for animals especially in young and disadvantaged people so that, as they matured, they would develop a more rounded, generous and compassionate character which would on turn benefit the whole of society.

Animals of every kind have come to the Sanctuary over the years, being nursed back to good health and then re-homed if suitable. Some animals have taken permanent residence with us and will continue to live out their lives here. In the past the Society rescued many pit ponies from the mines of Lancashire, whilst today, donkeys, discarded racehorses and other large animals find contentment at the Sanctuary.

Today, the Sanctuary still pursues its original aims. Parts of the Sanctuary are always busy, with people choosing pets for re-homing, while other parts are quiet and peaceful, giving respite to the gentle giants, too frail or elderly to be re-homed. The Sanctuary requires constant work to comply with today's animal welfare and visitor safety standards if it is to continue the Society's work of encouraging educational visits by children's groups and others. The Society has plans in place for the future and with sufficient finance will be helping animals and promoting humane principals for all living things, for many years to come.
